	digital third place, to know a set of tools that will	
	meet the person regardless of the physical place	
	where the person is.	
	Homes for dependent elderly persons could also	
	increasingly be third places. Welcoming a whole	
	bunch of other audiences, and there, the "virtual"	
	has its place.	
	It's like a current division of work between	
	telework at home and domestic work: whereas	
	when we absolutely wanted to separate them, now	
	we create frictions between the two worlds. This is	
	what the HOPE IN US project wishes to encourage.
